

Check List for Registration Work

Applicants must be current members of the AMERICAN MINIATURE JERSEY ASSOCIATION & REGISTRY

REPORT OF BIRTH

1. Make this report within 6 months of birth. Both parents must be AMJA&R Registered.
2. Follow the instructions on the back side of the Report of Birth form.
3. Be sure to complete ALL blanks on the form
4. Send the appropriate fees. \$25.00 per birth report.
5. Send one good photo of the calf with it's dam

REGISTRATION APPLICATION

1. To be submitted to the AMJA&R upon expiration of the Birth Certificate when the animal reaches three years of age (maturity) and will at this time be given Permanent Registration status as a Miniature-42" and under or Mid Miniature over 42" but not over 46".
2. Follow the instructions on the back side of the Registration Application.
3. Be sure to complete ALL blanks on the form.
Height to be measured and recorded at the #4 blank.
4. Send the appropriate fees. \$10.00 to bring animals from Birth Certificate to Permanent Registration status.
\$10.00 for Breeding Stock dams - females chosen by breeder to use in the Miniature Jersey upbreeding program. (These animals are not Birth Reported and will receive a Breeding Stock Registration status to give identity to all parentage on the Miniature Jersey progeny.
5. Send one good current photo of the animal.

TRANSFER AND BREEDERS CERTIFICATE

1. To be completed and submitted to the AMJA&R promptly upon purchase. Seller to complete the form. Buyer to submit the transfer form along with the original Birth Certificate or Registration Certificate and fees of \$10.00 (within the first 60 days of ownership) or \$20.00 (after 60 days of ownership.)
2. Follow the instructions on the back side of the Transfer Application &/or Breeders Certificate.
3. Complete ALL blanks, #1-6 unless the animal is a bred female in which case #7-12 also need to be completed.

PRIVATE HERD RECORD

This record of an owner's herd with details of new additions, sales, deceased animals, etc. is to be submitted to the AMJA&R along with Registration work. AMJA&R to maintain a copy of this form in the member's file.

Common Errors to avoid:

1. Be sure to Birth Record calves before 6 months of age. Take photos of the calf with it's mother before the calf gets too old to be easily photographed with her.
2. Photo size is not an issue as the photos are now scanned and sized at the AMJA&R office.
3. Complete the forms in their entirety.
